PURPOSE

Council resolution is required for the following road closures that will take place for the 2013 Mayoral Christmas Parade activities, to be held on Sunday 22 December 2013.

RECOMMENDATION

That the District Council of Robe having considered Report No 14.1.1 “Mayoral Christmas Parade – Road Closure Requirements” pursuant to the powers conferred on the Minister for Transport by Section 33 of the Road Traffic Act 1961 and delegated to Council by the Minister on 12th March 2001, the District Council of Robe hereby advises:

That the event known as “Mayoral Christmas Parade” to be an event to which Section 33 of the Road Traffic Act 1961 applies and, makes this order, temporarily closing the following streets in the Robe Township.

(a) The following roads will be closed to traffic from 3.30pm to 5.00pm Sunday 22 December 2013:

- Victoria Street between Squires Drive intersection and Davenport Street intersection

(b) The following roads will be closed to traffic from 3.30pm to 8.00pm Sunday 22 December 2013:

-Mundy Terrace: from the intersection of Davenport Street to the intersection of Bagot Street, and

Makes an order exempting persons participating in the event from the following Australian Road Rules:

230 – Crossing a road [general]

- 238 – Pedestrians travelling along a road [except in or on a wheeled recreational device or toy]**
- 268 – How persons must travel in a vehicle do not exceed the speed of 25km/hr on the portions of the road described above during the period specified above.**
- 298 – Driving with a person in a trailer only when the participating vehicles do not exceed the speed of 25km/hr on the portion of the road described above and during the period above.**

BACKGROUND & DISCUSSION

Council has had a request from the Christmas Parade Committee to close the roads near the Robe Institute and foreshore area, for the purpose of the 2013 Christmas Parade.

The parade commences at the school, moves down Victoria Street and Mundy Terrace to the Robe Institute.
