**PURPOSE**

Seeking Council approval to temporarily close Morphett Street between the intersection of Morphett and Lord Syleham Streets and the entrance to the Robe Golf Club for the Football Final held on the Robe Oval on the 7<sup>th</sup> September 2013.

**RECOMMENDATION**

**That the District Council of Robe having considered Report 18.1 “Temporary Road Closure Morphett Street – Football Final” pursuant to the powers conferred on the Minister for Transport in Section 33 of the Road Traffic Act 1961 and delegated to Council's by the Minister on 12 March 2001, the District Council of Robe:**

- (a) Hereby advises that the event known as the “Mid South East Football League Football Final” be an event to which Section 33 of the Road Traffic Act 1961 applies and; makes this order, temporarily close Morphett Street Robe in the Robe Township to traffic between 10.00am and 3.00pm Saturday 7 September 2013, between Morphett Street /O'Halloran Street intersection and the entrance to the Robe Golf Club.**
- (b) Makes an order exempting persons participating in the event from the following Australian Road Rules;**
  - (1) 230 – Crossing a road [general],**
  - (2) 238 – Pedestrians traveling along a road [except in or on a wheeled recreational device or toy]**

**The District Council of Robe in granting this temporary road closure request the Robe Football Club inform all residents and business that require access to Morphett Street of the temporary closure.**

## **BACKGROUND & DISCUSSION**

A Football final for the **Mid South East Football League** is scheduled to be held on the Robe Oval on the 7<sup>th</sup> September 2013. The temporary close of Morphett Street will assist the Football Club in controlling access to the Oval and controlling the conditions of the Football Clubs Liquor License.
