PURPOSE

To consider a request from South East Excavations to close Thompson Road (between Robe and Sneath Streets) for a period of approximately 2 weeks from the end of January/ early February to allow connection of STEDs for the Hills Sites Pty Ltd subdivision.

RECOMMENDATION

That Council approve the closure of Thompson Street (between Robe and Sneath Streets) to allow for the STEDs connections to be installed on the understanding that alternate access to properties affected by the road closure will be arranged and that the road will be repaired back to its current standard at a minimum.

BACKGROUND

In order for STEDs connection work to take place for the Hills Site Pty Ltd subdivision, it will be necessary to close of a portion of Thompson Road, between Robe and Sneath Streets to ensure that this work can be carried out as quickly and as safely as possible.

DISCUSSION

If the Hills Site Pty Ltd subdivision project is to move forward it is necessary for the STEDs work to be carried out. The quickest and safest means to do this is by closing off access to the areas of road affected for the required time period.
