Animal Management Plan

Cr Boylan moved that in respect to the Animal Management Plan for the area that:

(1) *Limit of Dog Numbers*

- (a) The limit on the number of dogs kept in any dwelling in the township shall be two dogs
- (b) The limit on the number of dogs kept in any dwelling outside of the township shall be three dogs (other than working dogs)
- (c) No person shall, without obtaining the written permission of the Council, keep any dog on any premises where the number of dogs on those premises exceeds the limit unless the premises are an approved kennel establishment

(2) *Areas Set Aside where Dogs are Prohibited*

- (a) Main Beach, Robe from the Post Office to Sea Vu Caravan Park
- (b) Long Beach - First Ramp to rocks

(3) *Off-Leash Areas*

- (a) Wrights Bay
- (b) Long Beach - north of Third Ramp to Mt Benson Drain (excluding Guichen Bay Conservation Park)
- (c) Lipson Park
- (d) West Beach
- (e) Karatta Beach
- (f) Hoopers Beach

All other parks and beaches dogs must be under effective control by means of physical restraint.
