## A message from the mayor

Well this month has been far from boring! It has highlighted the vast range of things that Elected Members deal within their Council roles on behalf of our community.

The list of things we have been discussing includes, but isn't limited to:

- Investors showing interest in Robe
- Planning and Development changes and what that means for our community
- GM-crop consultation on behalf of the State Government
- Signage and wayfinding workshop including community members to develop an entrance statement for Robe which will then set the tone for all signs around the town
- Annual Business Plan and Budget adoption
- Community meeting at the end of August (30/8/20) to discuss Council's plan to develop a prospectus for potential investors in Robe.

Coastal erosion is once again at the forefront of our minds as we watch what is happening along the eastern seaboard. Sand replenishment has been completed at Fox and Hooper's beach for 2020. Much of the sand has already been lost in recent storms but we understand that it is sacrificial. There are 2000 plants that will be distributed throughout the dunes at the end of this month with the help of the Robe Primary School and other community members/groups. Hopefully this will stabilise the dunes to some extent and give us time to develop a long term solution to protect the town and it's beaches. We are currently seeking grant funding to conduct coastal research with Flinders University as a partner. Also the report by Wavelength on the cliff erosion from first ramp to West Beach has been completed and will be presented to Council in August.

It is really heartening to see some of the things that we have discussed over the past 18 months start to take shape. Robe continues to move forward and the general feel is one of positivity throughout the community. Also on the up side is watching our town come back to life after restrictions. Many of our businesses are reporting they are having summer type figures for June-July which is fabulous. Many people are discovering Robe for the first time and are saying they can't wait to return. Obviously there is still a long way to go on this COVID-19 journey but we should all be proud of how things are going for our district at the moment.

We are still waiting for our SpendMapp data which will tell us how many people were here over summer and the following months. Obviously things will be skewed due to COVID-19 but the data will be interesting none the less. Elected Members wish Trevor Hondow all the very best in his retirement. Very few people can say they have worked for the same organisation for 30 years in the same town. His input into our district during that time has been highly valued by the community.

Elected Members also welcome Molly Murdock as the new Customer Service trainee and Rob Moir as the new Director of Infrastructure. Also we congratulate William Pavia (Councils Finance Officer) and his family on the arrival of their new baby boy, Ricardo. We are excited to have his whole family in the Robe community soon. Welcome back to the Coastal Leader and local reporter Lachie Smith it's lovely to have our local paper back up and running.

That saying about "if you're standing still, then your actually going backwards" definitely doesn't apply to Robe or it's Council at the moment. Exciting times ahead!



### Best Ociana Building Demolition

Best Ociana is still waiting for SA Power Networks to disconnect the power so that the demolition can commence. We will notify the public through Facebook and Council's website once dates have been confirmed.

### Disability Inclusion Plan

Council is required to develop a Disability Inclusion Plan and will be seeking to prepare the Plan in consultation with community. To commence this process Council will establish a working group with a broad representation from the community.

Members would include senior staff, Councillor Wright, people living with disability, family members, representative bodies, service providers, influential 'champions' or interested community members.

### Review of Airfield Hanger Leases

The District Council of Robe is in the process of reviewing lease arrangements for Hangers at Robe Airport. This review includes consultation with current lessees. Following consultation, the matter will be considered at a future Council meeting.

## MyLocal Services App

MyLocal Services is a mobile phone app that allows you to report a problem within the Council area, receive notifications about waste collection days and check Waste Transfer Station opening times. The app is designed to make it more convenient to find Council information 24/7. You'll never forget bin day again!!

You can also find places 'Near Me' such as parks and playgrounds.

We encourage all residents and ratepayers to download the App. It is very easy to use, and the details are specific to your house location.

MyLocal Services App can be downloaded from the Apple App Store and Google Play.



## Market Engagement and Innovation Policy and Procedures

New market engagement and innovation policy and procedures were adopted by elected members at the July Council meeting. These changes were adopted to better service our community's interests, through exploring, investigating, engaging and interacting with the market on opportunities that will facilitate our strategic objectives. These have been identified through strategic assessment, Elected Member Forums, community engagement, local business persons and other entrepreneurs seeking to explore innovation and opportunities within Robe and the wider region.

These new policies and procedures are available on the District Council of Robe website.

## COVID-19 Rate Relief Policy

In support of our community, Council has extended the time that the COVID-19 Rate Relief Policy is available to businesses and residents who have been significantly impacted by the pandemic. The policy sets out to provide rate relief to ratepayers who are experiencing financial hardship due to unemployment,

business closure or significant reduction in turnover in Robe during the Pandemic Health Event COVID-19 as announced by the Federal Government of Australia and the State Government of South Australia.

Please be aware that the Hardship Provision under this Policy will only apply to the ratepayer's principal residence and/or a business physically located in Robe and owned by a Robe ratepayer. Any other financial hardship application will be considered by Council under the provisions of Section 182 of the Local Government Act 1999.

The waiver of fines and interest have been extended to 1 December 2020 and to also now include first quarter rates for 2020/21.

## Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act

South Australia is currently undergoing the biggest modernisation of its planning system in 20 years. The renewed planning system is underpinned by the new Planning, Development and Infrastructure Act 2016 and introduces a raft of new tools and a 24/7 digital ePlanning system that will allow South Australians quick and easy access. The change will also mean that we will no longer have a Council Assessment Panel for applications as we move to set up a Regional Assessment Panel in partnership with the District Council of Grant, the City of Mount Gambier and Wattle Range Council.

Your Council will operate under the new system commencing 31 July 2020. Please be patient with our employees as they get used to the new system.

## Genetically Modified Crops

Council has been informed of recent legislative changes regarding Genetically Modified (GM) Crops in South Australia and Council's role, if it chooses, to apply to the Minister Primary Industry and Regional Development to maintain the District Council of Robe as a non-GM crop area. The Genetically Modified Crops Management Act 2004 (SA) (GMCM Act) provides for the designation of areas of South Australia in which no genetically modified food crops may be cultivated (non-GM crop areas).

The object of designating an area as a non-GM crop area is the **preservation of the identity of non-GM crops** for marketing purposes.

From the enactment of the GMCM Act, up until this year, the entire State was designated as a non-GM crop area. However, by virtue of recent variations to the Genetically Modified Crops Management Regulations 2008, this 'moratorium' has been lifted in respect of all parts of the State, except Kangaroo Island. An application made by a Council to the Minister **may only relate to the entire area of the Council (not specific parts of that area).**

It is at the discretion of the Minister as to whether any application will be successful. Before the Minister can determine that an application is successful, the Minister must first consult with, and take into account any advice provided by, the GM Crop Advisory Committee (a committee established under the GMCM Act) in relation to the matter. The Minister may also seek any other advice or information before determining an application.

The mechanism by which the Minister determines that an application is successful is the publication of a notice in the Gazette. That notice must be published before 15 November 2020. This is a deadline set by Parliament.

Under the GMCM Act as it now stands, there will not be any further opportunity for a Council to apply to become, or to otherwise be designated as, a non-GM crop area. This current transition period is the only opportunity for Council to make application to the Minister to have its Council area designated as a non-GM crop area.

Council needs to be aware that declining to make an application is effectively a decision that the Council will never be a non-GM crop area.

Consultation has commenced with two meetings being held with primary producers, one in the east of the Council area and a second meeting at Mount Benson. The feedback from these meetings will inform the recommendation to be put to Council.

### Shadow Cabinet Meeting

The District Council of Robe was pleased to present to the South Australian Shadow Cabinet on their visit to the Limestone Coast, along with the Councils of Tatiara, Kingston and Naracoorte Lucindale.

The meeting further provided an opportunity to showcase Robe and what it has to offer South Australians. The Shadow Cabinet met with all 7 Limestone Coast councils and conducted public forums in Naracoorte and Mount Gambier as an initiative to assist in developing policy for the next election.



### Limestone Coast Grassroots Grants

The Grassroots Grants program supports individuals, volunteers, community groups and other organisations working on a not-for-profit basis, with local landscape management projects. There is a funding pool of \$250,000, with minimum grants of \$1,000. Types of projects can include:

- Revegetation work
  - Trialling sustainable farming practices
  - Pest control
  - Monitoring and biological assessment
  - Water efficiency initiatives
  - Education activities and raising community awareness and participation in landscape management activities
- Projects must be aligned to one or more of the Limestone Coast Landscape Board's four investment priorities:
- Soil and land - Maintaining the health of soils and land
  - Water - Maintaining water quality and availability
  - Pest plants and animals - Minimising impacts of pest plants and animals
  - Biodiversity - Conserving native vegetation, wetlands and coastal habitats

Applications close 24 August 2020, projects must be completed by 30 June 2021.

The plan is to leave the end as open space with appropriate easements for key services.


