### Preparation for Fire Season


This year's winter and spring have provided abundant growth and the fuel load is likely to be high. Now is the time to commence preparations for the Fire Season. Flammable growth inspections will commence at the start of November, with notices going out on 8 November 2013. The Bush Fire Season start date is 22 November 2013. Dates are subject to change dependent on conditions.

### Robe Tourism Association

The voice of Robe's tourism and business interests held its AGM on 23 September 2013. The general meeting followed this. The various sub committees presented their reports and there were great contributions offered by those in attendance. The success of this important organisation for Robe's business wellbeing depends on your business being a member and contributor. Make the effort to get along and observe and consider joining up.

### Police Remembrance Day

## Australia Day Awards 2014 Nominations

The District Council of Robe would like to invite nominations for the 2014 Australia Day Awards, for person(s)/groups who have made outstanding contributions to the community. The three categories are as follows:

**Citizen of the Year:** To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen.

**Young Citizen of the Year:** To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen under 30 years of age, as at 26 January 2014.

**Community Event of the Year:** Presented to the person/group who has staged the most outstanding community event during the year.

### Undergrounding Power lines

Council over the past months has received several requests for Council to consider undertaking an undergrounding of the power lines projects in partnership with the Power Lines Environment Committee (PLEC). If Council does support an application to PLEC and the application is successful in obtaining PLEC funding, Council is responsible for 1/3 rd of the costs of the project in addition to being required to prepare and implement streetscaping plans once the undergrounding project has been completed. Council is prepared to support applications for undergrounding the power on streets where all the property owners are supportive of the application and are prepared to contribute to Council's share of the project costs.

### Retirement Living

The community has again identified through the Robe 2040 consultation, that retirement living is still a priority for Robe. Council currently own and operate Casuarina Lodge at Hateley Crescent, a property with 7 units upon it and a considerable amount of vacant land that abuts the golf course. Council has advertised for expression of interest from retirement living providers who may be interested in further developing this site and providing additional retirement living services for the town. Council is also seeking interested members of the community in forming a focus group to assist Council in assessing the registrations of interest received and developing options to enable Council to move this matter forward.

#### Retirement Living focus group

### Regional Trails Master Plan

Council as part of the South East Local Government Association (SELGA) has been successful in obtaining grant funding to prepare a Regional Trails Master Plan. The geography of the South East is ideally suited for the establishment of walking, cycling and horse riding trails and the development of a Regional Plan will;

- Assist the South East Councils coordinate their individual trails so that patrons can easily move from one region to the next,
- Assist in sourcing funding to help develop trails
- Assist in the promotion of recreational tourism.

### Changes to Council Policies

Recent changes to legislation relating to the establishment of the Independent Commission Against Corruption (ICAC) and the Office of Public Integrity (OPI) have required Council to amend its policies that set out how Council will manage the following subjects;

- Whistle Blower Protection Policy,
- Fraud and Corruption Prevention Policy, and
- Elected Members Code of Conduct – Complaints Handling Procedure.

**Coastal Protection works**

The recent spate of rough weather which included a north westerly swell has caused further damage to the coastal dunes along town beach. Officers from Coast Protection have met with officers of Council to plan remedial works along town beach which will protect the dunes, and therefore the properties that adjoin the dunes, should we receive future similar weather patterns. This work will commence with the repairs to the rock groyne at the eastern end of town beach and a sand replenishment project which will place sand on Town Beach to protect the foreshore dunes and adjacent private property. The sand will be removed from Karatta Beach, trucked through the town and deposited on Town beach adjacent the public toilets at the foreshore. Heavy machinery will then be used to move the sand along the beach to form two small dunes adjacent the existing foreshore dune. This work will commence as soon as weather and tides permit and while there will be some disruption to the ability of people to access town beach it is planned that this disruption will be minimal.

**Coastal walking Trail**

As previously reported Council has received funding of \$100,000 to formalize the coastal trail between the Drain L outlet and McIntyre Reserve. Council will be undertaking this work in the near future and the surface treatment will be of a colour similar to the local limestone occurring in the locality. This will assist in reducing the visual impact of the coastal trail.



Living in a bush setting is a lifestyle choice and the benefits are enormous, but so are the risks. The new start of a new bushfire season is nearly upon us and it is time to start thinking of what we need to do to prepare. While fires are inevitable, they are also survivable and your chances of saving yourself, your family and your home increase according to your level of planning and preparation. The CFS will not always be available to protect each individual property threatened by fire. Preparation of your home and property is an essential key to ensure that you, your property and your family survive. A well prepared home is more likely to survive a bushfire than one that hasn't. As a component of this, Council will again be conducting house and block inspections in and around Robe in the first week of November. Council urges you to be Bushfire Ready by developing a Bushfire Action Plan and preparing your property for the impending bushfire season.

**Redevelopment of the Lake Butler Marina Entrance**

Council has adopted a concept plan which when implemented will redevelop the entrance to the marina, improving the traffic flow, car parking and give prominence to the Fisherman's Memorial. Work will commence in removing the obstructions within the area and line marking the area delineating the new design for the entrance. This will give users of the area and Council an opportunity to see how the new concept will work and allow for amendments if needed prior to physical infrastructure being put in place. Council is confident that upon completion this will improve the amenity of this icon of the town, raise the profile of the Fisherman's Memorial and improve the movement of traffic in the area.

**Business Continuity Plan**

As part of the process of managing Council's risk, Council has adopted a Business Continuity Plan which sets out how Council will continue to provide services to the community should the Council suffer a catastrophic event. i.e. Fire. In recent times two Council Administration Buildings have been destroyed by fire and the implementation of their Business Continuity Plans have resulted in these Councils being able to continue to provide services to their residents the very next day. **The Wimmera Hearing Society** provides free hearing screenings to Western Victoria. We will be visiting Robe at the Foreshore car park on Friday November 15<sup>th</sup>, between 10am-4pm

The society is a non for profit organisation, based in Horsham. We do not sell or sign people up for any further testing or hearing aids. Our service provides each person with the results of their hearing screening and any further recommendations that we feel are required. Any referral will be to your own Doctor.

We have been providing this service to the Wimmera and Western Victoria for 30 years. All staff have been trained in audiology and counselling.

Our services offers residents of small communities the opportunity to have their hearing checked with a pure tone hearing screening, recommendations can include, referral to Doctor, for further investigation. Communication strategies, to assist persons that have a minor hearing loss. Minor repairs to hearing aids along with education about wearing hearing aids. A small number of hearing assistive devices are also on display for the public to try, these include: TV devices and volume controlled Telephones.

If you can relate to any of the follow, it may be time to get your hearing checked:

- ▶ Turning the TV up louder than other members of the household
- ▶ Asking people to repeat themselves
- ▶ Have trouble hearing conversation in a crowd or at a meeting
- ▶ Can't hear in the car when traveling
- ▶ Think that people now mumble, instead of the old days when they were taught to speak clearly
- ▶ People don't speak clearly on the telephone

Its time you came and had a hearing test.

Your hearing screening will give an indication of how you are hearing and if you happen to fail, we will direct you to professional providers that will assist, or give you communication tips that will assist you.

The Wimmera Hearing Society has been travelling around Western Victoria for many years providing this service. Two years ago we launched a new mobile testing unit and now have the capacity to expand our service to other parts of rural Victoria. The Hearing Society is funded via Medicare Local, part of the Department of Health and Ageing.

All staff complete intensive training annually, to keep abreast with the latest hearing technology and have complete audiometry training.





**Pumpkin & Bacon Soup**

Ingredients

- 1 tbs olive oil
- 1 brown onion, sliced
- 2 celery sticks, sliced
- 100g bacon, sliced
- 1kg pumpkin, peeled and deseeded- roughly chopped
- 600g potatoes, peeled and diced
- 2L (8 cups) chicken stock
- Season with cracked black pepper
- Sour cream and chives to serve

Method

1. Heat oil in large saucepan over medium heat. Add onion and celery, cook for 1 minute and then add bacon. Cook until bacon browns and onion and celery soften.
2. Add pumpkin, potatoes and stock to the pot, cover and bring to the boil, reduce heat to a simmer and cook partially covered for 25-30 mins or until pumpkin is tender. Set aside to cool slightly.
3. Using a blender or food processor, blend soup in batches. Return to the pot, season with cracked pepper. Stir over low heat until warmed though.
4. Serve topped with sour cream and chives
