Farewell to Lucy, Mark and Rob





Mayor, Elected Members & CEO Message

A summary of the outcomes from the November 2023 Ordinary Council Meeting is shown below:

- •The Councillors received the Ombudsman Report Casuarina Lodge. In his letter, the Ombudsman:
 - advised that he considered disclosure of his decisions to be in the public interest;
- authorised the former Acting Chief Executive Officer to disclose his letter as she saw fit; & closed the matter.
- ·Council revoked part of a resolution from the Special Meeting on 30 August 2023. The following points were revoked:
- 5. Authorise the Chief Executive Officer to engage local agents in accordance with Council's procurement policies
- 6. From the 1st of October, stop all short term rentals excluding 5% of berths retained for use by touring boats
- 7. The existing short-term tenants are to be offered the first opportunity to purchase available berth leases at time of sale. (159/2024)
- ·Council considered and adopted Policy 2.3 'Code of Practice for Access to meetings and documents' policy and Policy 2.16 'Treasury Management'. The policies are now available on Councils website for viewing
- ·Council also considered and adopted a Behavioural Support Policy for the Elected Members. The Policy also includes the values that the Elected Members are to abide by.
- ·Council resolved to approve the Robe Football Club's food stall development and development application fee reimbursement
- •The draft Annual Report 2022/23 was approved pending the inclusion of the 2022/23 Financial Statements and the LCLGA Annual Report 2022/23.
- ·Elected Members resolved to allocate LRCI Phase 4 Stimulus Funding to Jenny Matthews Playground and the Construction of a Walking Path from West Beach to Evans Cave Road.
- ·Council resolved to apply for grant funding for the establishment of a Heavy Vehicle Rest Area on Southern Ports Highway.
- ·Council approved the Memorandum of Understanding for the Robe History Group for the use of the Kathleen Browne Room.
- ·Council adopted the revised Terms of Reference and appointed Mr David Hope and Mr Deane Nankivell as the independent members of the Audit and Risk Management Committee. The revised Terms of Reference and Independent Members will come into effect on 24 November 2023.

- Norfolk Island tree lighting completed. Upgraded festoon lighting will commence installation in the new year. A qualified arborist was engaged to report on the condition of the tree with recommendations for ongoing maintenance being carried out by staff.
- New signage 2024. New welcome signage will be installed on major roads entering the
 District Council of Robe boundaries. Wayfinding and information signage at local points of
 interest have been designed, as well as an upgrade to the Main Road Information Bay
 billboard.
- Shelter installation (Jenny Mathews Playground & Information Bay) 2024

Robe Township - No free camping sites



Short Term Dry Zone 2023/24

Over recent years, following consultation with South Australia Police (SAPOL), Council has put in place two Dry Zone Areas within the township of Robe to cover the weekend leading up to and including NYE to assist in moderating behaviour over the Christmas to NYE period.

The Dry Zone has proved successful in managing the behaviour of visitors to town without having any adverse impact on the businesses within the town and visitors enjoyment of the holiday period. This year the dry zone period for the below areas is as follows:

12 noon, Friday 22 December 2023 until 12 midnight, Monday 1 January 2024.



Speed Limits on South Australian Beaches Reduced

As part of the Malinauskas Government's commitment to the Road Safety Action Plan 2023-25, a review of speed limits on beaches was conducted earlier this year and found clear support from South Australians to reduce the default speed limit.

80 per cent of all respondents were in favour of a reduction to the default speed limit, with the most preferred option being a reduction to 40km/h and 25km/h when within 100 metres of a pedestrian.

Following the consultation run by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport, a decision was reached to reduce the default speed limit to 40km/h and 25km/h within 50 metres of a pedestrian. The change will come into effect on Friday 1 December 2023.

Council will be promoting the change to the Community and Visitors to town to remind them of the change.

Limestone Coast Landscape Board Release of K5 Virus for Rabbit Control

Please be advised the Limestone Coast Landscape Board have completed a release of the Calicivirus (K5) for Rabbit control.

K5 only affects Rabbits and is not detrimental to domestic pets. However, it is recommended that pet owners check the vaccination records of their pets to ensure they are up to date.



Default speed limits on South Australian beaches will change to 40km/hour and 25km/hour within 50m of a person, unless otherwise signposted, from 1 December 2023.

We encourage all residents and ratepayers to download the App. It is very easy to use, and the details are specific to your house location. MyLocal Services App can be downloaded from the Apple App Store and Google Play.

ENOTICES

Please note that the current rates notices contain a new feature, 'Enotice' which will make it easier for our ratepayers to manage their rates. Ratepayers will need to use the reference number, top right of your rates notice, to login and create a new account:

The benefits of Enotice are;

- It is possible to see both current and previous rates notices using this feature.
- You can choose to have your rates notice emailed directly to you rather than posted.
- To allow ratepayers to update their email addresses and add email recipients. (e.g. if more than one person has an interest in the property)
- For ratepayers who own multiple properties this feature will be of great use, as you are able to add multiple assessments to the one account, creating a more efficient way to manage all properties.

Please note that this function does not allow you to update your residential or postal address, this still needs to be sent directly to Council. This can either be emailed to councilerobe.sa.gov.au or posted to PO Box 1, Robe SA 5276.

The Free Presbyterian Chaple - Sturt St - The Wee Free, The Kirk, Scots Kirk



The Free Presbyterian Chapel stands besides St Peter's Anglican Church, it is one of the most important early building so the town. The Kirk is the second church build in the district. Built in 1858 for the Presbyterians it has been widely used by all Protestant denominations. Besides a place of worship, it was also well utilised as a meeting place by many other groups including Robe Temperance Society (1862) and the Mechanics Institute (1862-68). During this time, it was a venue for many lectures and social events as well as housing a library including British newspapers and books. A Museum was opened in the building in 1865 and a school in 1869, and in more recent times it was used as a Sunday school.

The building fell into disrepair as the town's prosperity declined. In 1984 a group of enthusiastic locals gained permission (but not financial assistance) from the Anglican Church to restore the building. As a result of community support and fundraising the building as brought back to life.

The Kirk is State Heritage listed

The large Huon pine table – the statement piece of the building – was originally housed in the Mechanical Institute Library.






