Purpose

The purpose of this policy is to ensure that developers of existing allotments and landowners requesting the construction of limited use road access have a responsibility in ensuring that appropriate access roadways are provided.

Policy Statement

In consideration of any requests for upgrading of limited or single owner access roads over and above provision of standard maintenance requirements, be based on each case being negotiated between the party and council on its merit.

The Council will endeavour to accommodate reasonable requests provided they are within budget parameters.
