South Australian Coastal Council Alliance Coastal Forum

On Wednesday 28 September 2022, the Chief Executive Officer had the opportunity to present with Patrick Hesp and Charlotte Uphues from Flinders University and Nicholas Davies from Veris at the South Australian Coastal Council Alliance Coastal Forum.

The presentation was on the work undertaken on the Lidar of Robe's cliffs and the lessons learnt, preliminary findings from the research undertaken by Robe's Enterprise Scholarship PhD student, and next steps for longitudinal study of the coastline.

It was a great opportunity to share our experience with other Coastal Councils.

A new bush fire season is again nearly upon us.


Every year there are on average 756 bush fires throughout South Australia. They destroy homes, properties and lives every summer. You can increase your chances of survival by preparing yourself, your family and your home.

The more you prepare your property - better the chances are that it will survive a bush fire, even if you have a plan to leave well before a bush fire starts.

Council plays a key role in supporting our fire service by conducting block and house visual inspections in and around Robe in the last week of October - first week of November 2022. Council urges you all to prepare your property for the coming season, develop a Bush fire Action Plan and be bush fire ready.

High - Be ready to act

Extreme - Take action now to protect life and property

Catastrophic - For your survival, leave bushfire risk areas



'NO RATING' INTRODUCED

'No rating' is also introduced for days where no proactive action is required by the community. You will still need to be bushfire ready and follow local seasonal laws and regulations, but there is less risk of a fire that starts spreading in a dangerous or life-threatening way.



IMPLEMENTED CONSISTENTLY ACROSS AUSTRALIA

Wherever you are across the country, you will be able to understand the threat posed on any given day and make appropriate decisions to keep you and your family safe.

Robe Golf Club Land Swap

At the Special Council Meeting in August, Elected Members addressed the proposed land exchange with the Robe Golf Club. Thank you to all that put in submissions, the Elected Members appreciated the input from the community.

In total Council received 210 submissions. Of these, the assessment made shows that there were:

- 162 in support;
- 41 were against; and
- 7 were neutral.


The resolution is included on the following page along with a map of the land which Council resolved to subdivide. It is important to note that the parcel is currently dual zoned, Conservation and Recreational. An application will be submitted to separate the Golf Club land zoned Recreational from the Conservation zoned land.

Please see below the resolution passed by Council.

That the District Council of Robe having considered Report No. 6.1.2 'Public Consultation – Land Exchange':

- 1. note that the period of public consultation regarding the Land Exchange was conducted from 22 July 2022 to 22 August 2022, inclusive, in accordance with Council's Public Consultation Policy and in addition a Public Meeting held on 16 August 2022;
- 2.receive the 210 written submissions and acknowledge the community members who took time to make the submissions;
- 3. receive the letter from the Manager Coast and Marine at the Coast Protection Board, the notes taken from the Public Meeting and the answers provided by the Robe Golf Club to questions raised at the Public Meeting;
- 4. authorises the Chief Executive Officer to engage an appropriate consultant to close the unmade road reserve to the west of the Robe Cemetery land and incorporate it into Lot 1 Waterhouse Hundred, Robe in Certificate of Title Volume 6180 Folio 819;
- 5. instructs the Chief Executive Officer to immediately engage an appropriate consultant to subdivide the land so Council on behalf of the community retains the conservation zoned area and the Backler Street block;
- 6. approve the sale of Lot 1 Waterhouse Hundred, Robe in Certificate of Title Volume 6180 Folio 819 to the Robe Golf Club for \$1,045,000 (exclusive of GST) subject to:
 - a. a cultural heritage study and the excise of the land with cultural heritage value
 - b. the removal of the sand dunes (the area zoned as conservation);
 - c. removal of the Backler Street block; and
 - d. addition of the unmade road reserve (subject to completion of the formal road closure process).
- 7. authorise the Chief Executive Officer to present the portion of land (i.e. the land that is currently part of the golf course) that Council is prepared to make available to the Robe Golf Club;
- 8. subject to agreement being reached on the sale of the land zoned recreation, instructs the Chief Executive Officer to seek Ministerial approval for the revocation of community land classification for Lot 1 Waterhouse Hundred, Robe, being the recreation zoned portion of the land in Certificate of Title Volume 6180 Folio 819; and
- 9. subject to agreement being reached on the sale of the land zoned recreation, approve the purchase of approximately 8,785m2 of land owned by the Robe Golf Club Inc behind Hateley Crescent for up to \$1,045,000 (exclusive of GST), being portion of the land comprised in Certificate of Title Volume 6208 Folio 288 owned by the Robe Golf Club Inc. (43/2022)

ENOTICES

Please note that the current rates notices contain a new feature, 'Enotice' which will make it easier for our ratepayers to manage their rates. Ratepayers will need to use the reference number, top right of your rates notice, to login and create a new account:

The benefits of Enotice are;

- It is possible to see both current and previous rates notices using this feature.
- You can choose to have your rates notice emailed directly to you rather than posted.
- To allow ratepayers to update their email addresses and add email recipients. (e.g. if more than one person has an interest in the property)
- For ratepayers who own multiple properties this feature will be of great use, as you are able to add multiple assessments to the one account, creating a more efficient way to manage all properties.
