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RECOMMENDATION REPORTS

6.1.1 <u>Scott Gluyas – Temporary Marina Berth and Signage Request</u>

That the District Council of Robe having considered Report No. 6.1.1 'Scott Gluyas – Temporary Marina Berth and Signage Request' approve:

- 1. the short-term berth fee of \$7899.00 for three months being waived,
- 2. 1m x 1m signage being placed on the fence at the entry to the hard stand in the Lake Butler Marina
- 3. a fee of \$184.30 be charged for the 1m x 1m sign on fence
- 4. the seeking of feedback from the Marina Advisory Committee in relation to item 7 permitted use of the underlease. (74/2024)

That the District Council of Robe having considered Report No. 6.1.2 'Lake Butler Marina – Ádministration Fee and Sinking Fund' approve:

- 1. administration to investigate the process required to amend the existing underlease agreement to allow for all administration fees to be paid into the sinking fund
- 2. administration to investigate the process required to amend the existing underlease agreement to define the purpose of the sinking fund as being to meet payment of the contingent repairs and maintenance liabilities of the marina.
- 3. administration to investigate the process required to amend the existing underlease agreement to add into definitions "Sinking Fund" means a separate account opened to accumulate contributions to meet payment of the contingent liabilities and other expenses referred to in clause 6.2
- 4. administration to investigate the process required to amend 6.2.1 of the existing underlease agreement to read: The Under lessor will establish a Sinking Fund to fund provision for recurrent and major items of repair and maintenance to the Marina.
- 5. administration to investigate the process required to amend Clause 6.2.3 of the existing underlease agreement by removing the words "made from" in the second line.
- 6. administration to investigate the process required to amend Clause 6.2.4 of the existing underlease agreement of similar fees collected by the underlessor pursuant to the underleases and licenses it grants in relation to the marina shall be at the discretion of the underlessor
- 7. administration to investigate the process required to amend 6.2.5.3 of the existing underlease agreement to include (in the fourth line) payment of the contingent liabilities of maintenance and repair.
- 8. Upon clarification of processes required, administration to seek Ministerial consent to the changes to the sub-lease agreement.
- 9. Administration to review the Sinking Fund Procedure to include the funding of the Lake Butler Marina contingent and maintenance repair liabilities and present a draft of the updated Procedure to the Marina Advisory Committee for feedback
- 10. Administration to investigate adding into definitions "Contingent Liability" means the liability of the under lessor to meet and pay for the repairs and maintenance of the Marina pursuant to the Agreement and based on acceptable engineering practice and estimates calculated over the term of the Underlease and as those estimates relate to the assets of the Marina. (79/2024)

6.1.3 <u>Lake Butler Marina – Sale of Long Term Lease of Berths</u>

That having considered the report Lake Butler Marina – Sale of Long Term Lease of Berths Council resolve to:

- 1. Retain 5% of short-term rental for touring boat berths.
- 2. Conduct audit of berth leases available for sale including their location, size, power and water
- 3. Marina Advisory Committee to provide advice regarding berths to be retained, lease terms, berth values and the sale process
- 4. Seek marketing and sales programs from local agents within the Robe district including quotations
- 5. Authorise the Chief Executive Officer to engage local agents in accordance with Council's procurement policies
- 6. From the 1st of October, stop all short term rentals excluding 5% of berths retained for use by touring boats
- 7. The existing short-term tenants are to be offered the first opportunity to purchase available berth leases at time of sale. (80/2024)

6.1.4 <u>Lake Butler Marina – Waterhouse Berths</u>

That the District Council of Robe having considered Report No. 6.1.4 'Lake Butler Marina – Waterhouse Berths' require:

- administration to commence an investigation into the costings associated with the removal of the timber jetty in the Lake Butler Marina and provide a report to the Marina Advisory Committee upon completion of the investigation
- 2. administration to commence an investigation of costs, timing and process associated with the relocation of twelve shallow Waterhouse Berths and provide a report to the Marina Advisory Committee upon completion of the investigation. (81/2024)

6.1.5 <u>Lake Butler Marina – Refuelling Jetty</u>
