Meeting with Minister for Health & Wellbeing, Chris Picton MP

On Thursday 26 October 2023, the Chief Executive Officer (Acting) and I accompanied Community representatives responsible for the development of the Petition, Nick McBride MP Member for Mackillop, Dr David Senior and Robe Paramedic Liam McKay and others from the Limestone Coast Health Board to a meeting with Minister for Health & Wellbeing, Chris Picton MP. The purpose of the meeting was to discuss the GP Shortage and address the issue around the Paramedics position ending on 31 December 2023.

I am please to notify our community that Minister Picton has extended the Community Paramedics position to 30 June 2024.

We are still pushing for a permanent Community Paramedic position to be allocated to Robe, and I look forward to keeping you all updated as I know more.

Police Remembrance Day 2023

On Friday 29 September 2023, I attended the 2023 Police Remembrance Day Ceremony in Mount Gambier, South Australia.

This was a day for police to pause to honour officers whose lives have been lost in the line of duty. It is also a time to remember those officers who have sadly lost their lives due to illness or other circumstances.

Following an extensive recruitment process, Mayor Ruffell is pleased to announce the appointment of Ms Natalie (Nat) Traeger as the new Chief Executive Officer at the District Council of Robe, with this decision confirmed at Council's 11 October 2023 meeting.

Growing up in country South Australia, Ms Traeger has enjoyed an impressive 36-year career in Local Government. Developing her earlier career at the Coorong District Council, Ms Traeger progressed to a senior level having demonstrated a solid track record of success, heavily focussed on Human Resources, Corporate and Community Service areas.

After many years at Manager and Director level, Ms Traeger became CEO at Kingston District Council. Mayor, Elected Members & CEO Message

A summary of the outcomes from the October Ordinary Council Meeting is shown below:

•Discretionary Rate Rebate Request – Robe RSL: The Elected Members resolved to provide the Robe RSL with a discretionary rate rebate of 100% for their land.

•Child Care on Wheels Service Group Terms of Reference: The Terms of Reference for the Committee were resolved and updated. Existing Committee Members were reappointed to the Committee.

·Lake Butler Marina Hardstand Security Gate: Elected Members considered a request from the Marina Advisory Committee to investigate opening the Hardstand area during the summer period to provide more parking. It was resolved that Council do not open the Hardstand area due to safety concerns and that the administration investigate if installing a temporary fence around the work area would satisfy the safety concerns from Safework SA.

•Code of Practice for Access to Meetings and Documents Policy – the draft policy is currently out for public consultation and can be viewed on Council's website here: <u>www.robe.sa.gov.au/community/public-consultation</u> Interested persons are invited to make written submissions to the CEO by 12pm on Friday 3 November 2023 by email <u>council@robe.sa.gov.au</u> or by post PO Box 1, Robe SA 5276.

·Cr Duncan Young Marina Advisory Committee Resignation: Elected Members considered Cr Young's resignation from the Marina Advisory Committee and resolved to accept his resignation and reappoint him to the Committee.

•Policy Revocation – Asset Capitalisation Policy: Elected Members revoked the Asset Capitalisation Policy as it the contents was merged into the Asset Capitalisation & Materiality Thresholds Policy and therefore was a duplicated policy.

·Hardship Policy: Elected Members considered and adopted the updated and reviewed Hardship Policy.

•Delegations Update: Council considered proposed delegations to the Chief Executive Officer under Act's which have recently been updated. The Report and Recommendation was adopted by Elected Members.

•Procurement Policy: Elected Members considered and adopted the updated and reviewed Procurement Policy.

·LCLGA Charter: Elected Members considered the Limestone Coast Local Government Association Charter and approved it.

•Finance Report September 2023: The monthly Finance Report was adopted by Council.

•Treasury Management Policy: Elected Members considered and adopted the revised Treasury Management Policy. It should be noted that this policy will be brought back to the next Council Meeting including the Marina Sinking Fund provision contained within.

•Cruise Tender Boats Fee Waiver for Unloading/Loading Passengers: A fee waiver of \$140.70 per day for the tendering of Cruise Tender Boats until June 2026 was approved.

• Robe Run 2024 Sponsorship Request and Road Closure: In-kind support and a road closure was approved by Council for the 2024 Robe Run event. Mundy Terrace/Victoria Street from Bagot Street to Union Street with be closed between the hours of 7:00am and 9:30am on Saturday 10 February 2024.

•Heritage Advisory Group Expression of Interest: Mr Kim Kelly was appointed as a Community Representative on the Heritage Advisory Committee.

•Audit and Risk Management Committee Expression of Interest: The matter was deferred to the November 2023 Ordinary Council Meeting.

Speed Limits on South Australian Beaches Reduced

As part of the Malinauskas Government's commitment to the Road Safety Action Plan 2023-25, a review of speed limits on beaches was conducted earlier this year and found clear support from South Australians to reduce the default speed limit.

80 per cent of all respondents were in favour of a reduction to the default speed limit, with the most preferred option being a reduction to 40km/h and 25km/h when within 100 metres of a pedestrian.

Following the consultation run by the Department for Infrastructure and Transport, a decision was reached to **reduce the default speed limit to 40km/h and <u>25km/h within 50 metres of</u> <u>a pedestrian.</u> The change will come into effect on Friday 1 December 2023.**

Heritage Conservation Grant

The District Council of Robe has been successful in their grant application process for the project entitled 'Robe Historic Cemetery - Restoration Works' on behalf of community. The Department of Environment and Water will contribute \$20,000 towards the restoration works as part of the new Heritage Conservation Grants Program.

This program provides a total of \$2.5m in grant funding during the next decade – up from \$1.25m provided under the previous program initiated in 2018. South Australia has a rich heritage that contributes to our quality of life and connects us to our history and stories. Since 2018, the Heritage Grants Program has been funding conservation works with benefits including adaptive reuse of heritage buildings, support for heritage trades, and support for State Heritage Places in rural and urban areas across South Australia.

All Heritage Conservation Grant applications are

assessed by a Heritage Conservation Grants Assessment Panel and the grant has been endorsed by the Minister for Climate, Environment and Water.

We look forward to delivering this project to community over the financial year.

Upcoming fire prevention block inspections

The District Council of Robe prioritizes resident readiness for bushfires. Essential preparations include fuel reduction, vital in the upcoming weeks as understorey grasses, scrubland, and forestry areas dry out.

Effective fuel reduction involves clearing dead branches, undergrowth, pruning low tree limbs, and cutting grass under 10 cm within 20 meters of your home.

Council will begin property assessments in November. Non-compliance may result in Council intervention and fines.

MYLOCAL APP

My Local Services is a mobile phone app that allows you to report a problem within the Council area, receive notifications about waste collection days and check Waste Transfer Station opening times. The app is designed to make it more convenient to find **SERVICES** Council information 24/7.

You'll never forget bin day again!

You can also find places 'Near Me' such as parks and playgrounds.

We encourage all residents and ratepayers to download the App. It is very easy to use, and the details are specific to your house location. MyLocal Services App can be downloaded from the Apple App Store and Google Play.

ENOTICES

Please note that the current rates notices contain a new feature, 'Enotice' which will make it easier for our ratepayers to manage their rates. Ratepayers will need to use the reference number, top right of your rates notice, to login and create a new account:

The benefits of Enotice are;

- It is possible to see both current and previous rates notices using this feature.
- You can choose to have your rates notice emailed directly to you rather than posted.
- To allow ratepayers to update their email addresses and add email recipients. (e.g. if more than one person has an interest in the property)
- For ratepayers who own multiple properties this feature will be of great use, as you are able to add multiple assessments to the one account, creating a more efficient way to manage all properties.
