Squires Drive Carpark

Council have again created a temporary carpark on the Robe Primary School Oval, with entry off Squires Drive for the peak Summer period.

We encourage businesses to ask their staff to use this carpark, to avoid long term parking on Victoria Street over January.

Robe Sports and Recreation Association Lease

The Robe Sports and Recreation Association have requested a 20 year lease with Council for the area of the Robe Sporting Grounds located at 18-20 O'Halloran Street, Robe. Under Section 202 of the Local Government Act 1999, Council are required to consult with the community on a lease for a term longer than five years.

Council is very supportive of sporting endeavours in Robe and would like to see the continuation of the various sports at the Robe Sporting Ground over the next 20 years.

Amendment to the Robe Lakes Reserve Community Land Management Plan

Following the community consultation Council has approved the installation of the Entrance Statement at the Southern Ports Highway T-Junction.

As part of installing the Robe Entrance Statement, Council need to amend the Robe Lakes Reserve Community Land Management Plan to provide for the Entrance Statement and informational signage. Under the Local Government Act, any change to a Community Land Management Plan require community consultation.

Beach activity Zones

In preparation for the busy Summer season ahead Council has formalised the creation of Beach Activity Zones and the no camping on community land bylaws are to be enforced. This is to ensure the safety and enjoyment of our beaches and other community land by our community and visitors.

Implementation of the Beach Activity Zones and no camping on community land will require the following:

No Vehicles- the reinstallation of the traditional rock barrier west of second ramp at Long Beach, to prevent vehicle access to this section of beach.

No Boats/Watercraft- Declaring a recommended Personal Watercraft (PWC) exclusion zone- from the old slip way (including Town Beach, Hoopers and Fox) to one kilometre North of Steve Woolston Road (third ramp), 200m seaward of the low water mark. (see picture below)

- No beach launching/landing of motorised vessels will be permitted in this exclusion zone.
- The Personal Watercraft exclusion zone will apply between sunrise and sunset during the period between 1 December and Easter Monday (inclusive) in any year.

No Camping- By-Law 2 Local Government Land, Section 9.12 (No) 'Camping and Tents' will be enforced.

This means that camping on any Council land is prohibited and expiations will be used to offenders.

The By-Law is defined as: A person must not without the permission of the Council, do any of the following on Local Government Land- Beaches, Parks, Reserves, Carparks etc.

9.12. Camping and Tents

9.12.1 Erect a tent or other structure of calico, canvas, plastic or similar material, (including swags)

9.12.2 Camp or sleep overnight:

(a) unless in a caravan park on Local Government land, the proprietor of which has been given permission to operate the caravan park on that land; or

(b) other than in an area that the Council has, by resolution, designated for camping and in accordance with such time limits and other conditions determined by resolution of the Council (if any).

Council hopes the Beach Activity Zones and the enforcement of the no camping bylaw will make the town and beach an even friendlier place to be and we thank the Robe community and its visitors in advance for their cooperation to the changes that will be enforced.

Robe's Dry Zone for the Christmas Season

The township of Robe, as outlined in the maps below, will be a Dry Zone for the New Year's Eve weekend/period, meaning that the consumption and possession of liquor in public places is prohibited. The dry zone will apply between the hours of 12 noon Saturday 26 December 2020 until 12 midnight Monday 3 January 2021.



Community Wastewater Management Scheme—Desludging of Septic Tanks


As part of the operating and maintenance of Council's Community Wastewater Management System (CWMS), Council provides a septic tank desludging program to properties within the Robe township that are connected to the CWMS.


To prevent sludge passing into Council's drains our contractor, Envirogen Industrial Services attends each property on a four year cycle to remove accumulated sludge from the tanks. This work is done as an ongoing maintenance program, not as an emergency call out for plumbing blockages. The next sector to be deslужed is Sector 1, letters have been sent to rate payers who will be effected. Envirogen Industrial Services will notify rate payers as to when they are required to expose the septic tank

Are you thinking of building, landscaping, paving or constructing a driveway? It is critical to find out where your tank is and include this in your plan as adequate access to the lid of the tank (not the inspection point) is a must for maintenance and pumping. Construction on or near your septic system could damage the tank, pipes or soil.

Properties that are not connected to the CWMS, which dispose of their effluent to on-site soakage drain still need to be deslужed routinely at the owners expense.

DOGS OFF LEASH AREAS

The dog free areas are defined as follows:

- All ovals and sporting facilities where there is organised sport or community events taking place
- All reserves and parks except for those identified as dog exercise areas
- Within 100 meters of a school or playground except for defined footpaths and walking/bicycle tracks where dogs must be on a leash
- All other areas not designated as on-leash or off-leash areas.


Areas in Robe district that dogs can be walked on a leash are:

- All ovals and sports arenas at times when no organised sport or training or other community events are evident.
- Long Beach Foreshore.
- Long Beach north of first ramp and south of rock barrier (second ramp).
- Long Beach north of rock barrier (second ramp) and south of third ramp between 9am and 8pm from December 1 to after the Easter Weekend.
- Hoopers Beach (old sailing club) between 9am and 8pm from December 1 to after the Easter Weekend.
- Fox Beach.
- Karatta Beach.

- Nora Creina Bay Beach between 9am to 8pm from December 1 to after the Easter Weekend.
- Boatswain Point Beach between 9am and 8pm from December 1 to after the Easter Weekend.
- Town Beach and Foreshore from Post Office to Sea Vu Caravan Park.
- Lake Butler Marina.
- All streets, footpaths, jetties, walking and bicycle tracks within the townships of Robe, Boatswain Point and Greenways.

Areas in Robe district that dogs can be let off leash are:

- Wrights Bay.
- Lipson Park.
- West Beach.
- Long Beach north of third ramp to Boatswain Point Beach (excluding Guichen Bay Conservation Park).
- Long Beach north of rock barrier (second ramp) and south of third ramp except between 9am and 8pm from December 1 to after the Easter Weekend.
- Hoopers Beach (old sailing club) except between 9am and 8pm from December 1 to after the Easter Weekend.
- Nora Creina Bay Beach except between 9am and 8pm from December 1 to after the Easter Weekend.
- Boatswain Point Beach except between 9am and 8 pm from December 1 to after the Easter Weekend.
