The behavioural support policy is intended to support appropriate behaviour by Elected Members and forms part of the Behavioural Management Framework that resulted from the Statutes Amendment (Local Government Review) Act 2021. The policy sets out the behaviour that members of the District Council of Robe agree to observe in addition to the statutory Behavioural Standards published by the Minister for Local Government on 17 November 2022.

The policy is open to public consultation until 5pm Monday 9 October 2023. You are invited to provide feedback on the draft policy to the CEO before the closing date by emailing council@robe.sa.gov.au or by post PO Box 1 Robe SA 5276.

Mayor, Elected Members & CEO Message

A summary of the outcomes from the September Ordinary Council Meeting is shown below:

• Review of Delegations: The Delegations to the CEO were considered and adopted by Council. The purpose of this is for Elected Members to delegate responsibility to undertake certain sections of relevant Legislation to the Chief Executive Officer. This means that not every matter needs to be brought to the Elected Members for decision, making for a much more efficient business.

• Golf Club Lease Agreement – Elected Members resolved to arrange an information/briefing session on the background of this matter and to discuss and process moving forward. Executive Members of the Robe Golf Club will also be invited to come along and provide input to ensure Elected Members here from both sides.

• Behavioural Support Policy – Elected Members considered and approved the draft Behavioural Support Policy for public consultation seeking feedback from community. The public consultation period closes on Monday 9 October 2023. The draft policy can be viewed on Councils website: www.robe.sa.gov.au/community/public-consultation

• Section 222 Smith – The application from the Smiths to seek a permit to have private use of a portion of unmade road reserve was considered and it was resolved by Councils to refuse the application.

• Animal Management Plan – The Animal Management Plan was endorsed by Elected Members with some minor editorial changes to be made. The Plan is now live on Councils Website.

• Casuarina Lodge Rent Increase – Elected Members considered the current Casuarina Lodge rental prices and based on the Market Research completed by a local Real Estate agent, Elected Members resolved to increase the rent.

• Discretionary Rate Rebate Request Robe RSL – The Robe RSL submitted a request for a 100% rate rebate. Due to a lack of quorum, the matter was adjourned to the October Council Meeting for consideration.

• Discretionary Rate Rebate Request Robe Golf Club – The Robe Golf Club also submitted a request for a 100% rate rebate on there properties containing Golf Course. Elected Members considered the request and resolved to provide them with a 25% rate rebate.

• Robe Rod Run Car Display on Foreshore – Elected Members resolved to waive the hire fees for the foreshore for the Robe Rod Run Car Display which will be on 2 December 2023. Watch this space for more information on the event to come!

• Bike SA 2023 Annual Tour Limestone Coast – Elected Members resolve to waive the hire fees for the Institute for the Robe Lions Club to host Bike SA's lunch stop in Robe on 17 October 2023.

• Heritage Advisory Committee Expressions of Interest – Elected Members appointed Dr Darren Peacock and Margaret Fergusson to the Heritage Advisory Committee.

ENOTICES

Please note that the current rates notices contain a new feature, 'Enotice' which will make it easier for our ratepayers to manage their rates. Ratepayers will need to use the reference number, top right of your rates notice, to login and create a new account:

The benefits of Enotice are;

- It is possible to see both current and previous rates notices using this feature.
- You can choose to have your rates notice emailed directly to you rather than posted.
- To allow ratepayers to update their email addresses and add email recipients. (e.g. if more than one person has an interest in the property)
- For ratepayers who own multiple properties this feature will be of great use, as you are able to add multiple assessments to the one account, creating a more efficient way to manage all properties.

Please note that this function does not allow you to update your residential or postal address, this still needs to be sent directly to Council. This can either be emailed to council@robe.sa.gov.au or posted to PO Box 1, Robe SA 5276.
