Public Consultation – Behavioural Support Policy

The Elected Members considered and endorsed the Behavioural Support Policy for public consultation at the September 2023 Ordinary Council Meeting. You can view the draft policy on Council's website: www.robe.sa.gov.au/community/public-consultation

As Elected Members in South Australia, we have an obligation to serve the best interest of the people within the community we represent and to discharge our duties conscientiously, to the best of our ability and for public benefit at all times.

The behavioural support policy is intended to support appropriate behaviour by Elected Members and forms part of the Behavioural Management Framework that resulted from the Statutes Amendment (Local Government Review) Act 2021. The policy sets out the behaviour that members of the District Council of Robe agree to observe in addition to the statutory Behavioural Standards published by the Minister for Local Government on 17 November 2022.

The policy is open to public consultation until 5pm Monday 9 October 2023.

2024 NOMINATIONS NOW OPEN

DISTRICT COUNCIL OF ROBE AUSTRALIA DAY AWARDS

The District Council of Robe would like to invite nominations for the 2024 Australia Day Awards, for person(s)/groups who have made outstanding contributions to the community.

The three categories are as follows:

Citizen of the Year: This is presented to someone making an extraordinary contribution to the community and may recognise outstanding service over a number of years. To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen.

Young Citizen of the Year: This is presented to an inspirational role model who is making a difference in their community. To be eligible, the person must be an Australian Citizen aged over 16 years and under 30 years of age on January 26, 2024.

Community Event of the Year: This is presented to the person/group who has staged the most outstanding community event during the past year. To be eligible, the person or group must be Australian Citizens.

Nomination forms and guidelines for the awards are available from the Council Office or on Council's website: www.robe.sa.gov.au.

Nominations close 24 November 2023 at 5.00pm.



Mayor, Elected Members & CEO Message

A summary of the outcomes from the September Ordinary Council Meeting is shown below:

- Review of Delegations: The Delegations to the CEO were considered and adopted by Council. The purpose of this is for Elected Members to delegate responsibility to undertake certain sections of relevant Legislation to the Chief Executive Officer. This means that not every matter needs to be brought to the Elected Members for decision, making for a much more efficient business.
- Golf Club Lease Agreement – Elected Members resolved to arrange an information/briefing session on the background of this matter and to discuss and process moving forward. Executive Members of the Robe Golf Club will also be invited to come along and provide input to ensure Elected Members here from both sides.
- Behavioural Support Policy – Elected Members considered and approved the draft Behavioural Support Policy for public consultation seeking feedback from community. The public consultation period closes on Monday 9 October 2023. The draft policy can be viewed on Councils website: www.robe.sa.gov.au/community/public-consultation
- Section 222 Smith – The application from the Smiths to seek a permit to have private use of a portion of unmade road reserve was considered and it was resolved by Councils to refuse the application.
- Animal Management Plan – The Animal Management Plan was endorsed by Elected Members with some minor editorial changes to be made. The Plan is now live on Councils Website.
- Casuarina Lodge Rent Increase – Elected Members considered the current Casuarina Lodge rental prices and based on the Market Research completed by a local Real Estate agent, Elected Members resolved to increase the rent.
- Discretionary Rate Rebate Request Robe RSL – The Robe RSL submitted a request for a 100% rate rebate. Due to a lack of quorum, the matter was adjourned to the October Council Meeting for consideration.
- Discretionary Rate Rebate Request Robe Golf Club – The Robe Golf Club also submitted a request for a 100% rate rebate on there properties containing Golf Course. Elected Members considered the request and resolved to provide them with a 25% rate rebate.
- Robe Rod Run Car Display on Foreshore – Elected Members resolved to waive the hire fees for the foreshore for the Robe Rod Run Car Display which will be on 2 December 2023. Watch this space for more information on the event to come!
- Bike SA 2023 Annual Tour Limestone Coast – Elected Members resolve to waive the hire fees for the Institute for the Robe Lions Club to host Bike SA's lunch stop in Robe on 17 October 2023.
- Heritage Advisory Committee Expressions of Interest – Elected Members appointed Dr Darren Peacock and Margaret Fergusson to the Heritage Advisory Committee.

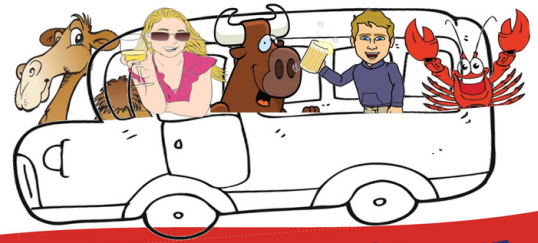

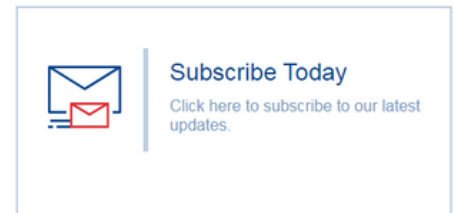

MYLOCAL SERVICES APP

My Local Services is a mobile phone app that allows you to report a problem within the Council area, receive notifications about waste collection days and check Waste Transfer Station opening times. The app is designed to make it more convenient to find Council information 24/7.

You'll never forget bin day again!

You can also find places 'Near Me' such as parks and playgrounds.

We encourage all residents and ratepayers to download the App. It is very easy to use, and the details are specific to your house location. MyLocal Services App can be downloaded from the Apple App Store and Google Play.

ENOTICES

Please note that the current rates notices contain a new feature, 'Enotice' which will make it easier for our ratepayers to manage their rates. Ratepayers will need to use the reference number, top right of your rates notice, to login and create a new account:

The benefits of Enotice are;

- It is possible to see both current and previous rates notices using this feature.
- You can choose to have your rates notice emailed directly to you rather than posted.
- To allow ratepayers to update their email addresses and add email recipients. (e.g. if more than one person has an interest in the property)
- For ratepayers who own multiple properties this feature will be of great use, as you are able to add multiple assessments to the one account, creating a more efficient way to manage all properties.

Please note that this function does not allow you to update your residential or postal address, this still needs to be sent directly to Council. This can either be emailed to council@robe.sa.gov.au or posted to PO Box 1, Robe SA 5276.

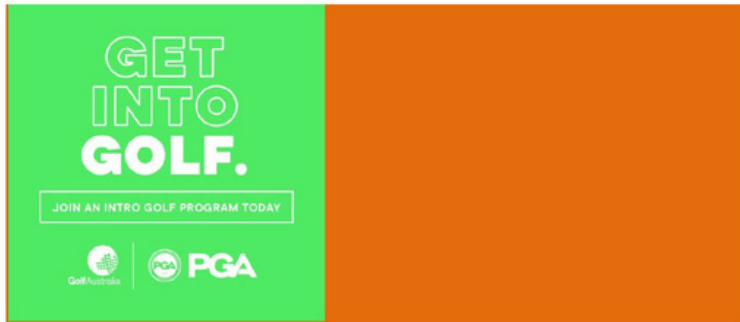
More than just a place!

Dog and Cat Management Board



From dogs we don't know to the cuddliest family pet, any dog has the potential to bite for all sorts of reasons. So it's vital we know the situations when and why dogs bite and how we can interact with dogs safely.

Safety tips:

- ▲ Always supervise children around dogs at home or in public.
- ▲ Never enter a dog's territory, like their bed, yard or toy box.
- ▲ Never startle a dog.
- ▲ Never touch a dog while it's eating.
- ▲ Never touch a dog's puppies without the owner's permission.
- ▲ Never disturb a sleeping dog.
- ▲ Never put your face near a dog's face.
- ▲ Teach children to always ask the owner's permission before approaching a dog.
- ▲ Remind children that dogs can bite when they're tired, frightened or annoyed and teach them the signals to look for.
- ▲ When approaching a dog, slowly reach to touch its chest from the side. If it retreats, it's time to back off.

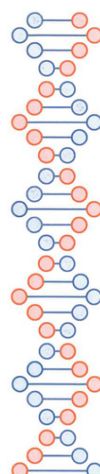

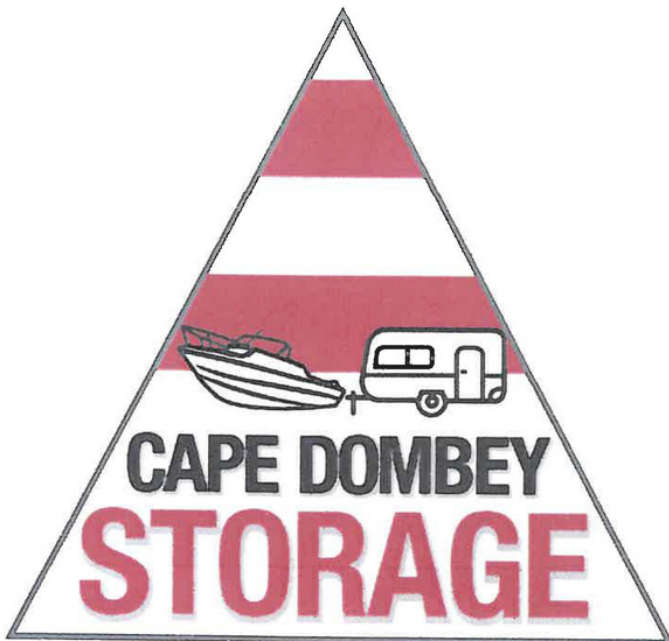

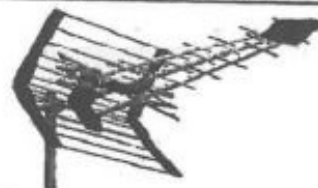
